GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF MANDATORY FEES AND CHARGES
(2017-2018)

The following is a list of selected mandatory fees and charges and a brief description of each. These descriptions are intended to be for general information purposes. If more detailed information is required, please contact Accounting Services at (432) 837-8042.

<u>Mandatory Fees and Charges</u>	<u>Description</u>
Tuition - Designated	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to help cover the cost of services, use and/or availability of all or any of the Universities property, buildings, structures, activities, operations or other facilities. These funds are used to support the Educational and General operations of the University (i.e. scholarships, equipment, and development). This fee is currently assessed@ \$140.00 per SCH
Student Service Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to help cover the cost of Student Services. Student Services are activities which are separate and apart from the regularly scheduled academic functions of the institution and directly involve or benefit students (i.e. Student Government, Student Counseling, and Athletics). This fee is currently assessed@ \$22 per SCH with a maximum of \$238.00 per semester.
Computer Access Charge	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to help cover the cost of operations of the Academic Computer Resource Center. This includes staff salaries, equipment, software, and other operating costs. This fee is currently assessed@ \$7.00 per SCH.
Property Deposits	This deposit is charged to insure the institution against losses, damages, and breakage in libraries and laboratories. The deposit shall be returned on the withdrawal or graduation of a student, less and loss, damage, or breakage caused by the student. This fee is currently assessed at \$10.00.
International Education Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to assist student participating in international student exchange or study programs. This assistance would be in the form of scholarships or other stipends. This fee is currently assessed@ \$1.00 per semester.
Medical Service Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to cover the cost of operations of the university health center, and for the cost of professional medical services. This fee is currently assessed at \$31.00 per semester.
Publications and Records Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to cover the cost of materials or services of publications, including transcripts. This fee is currently assessed at \$12.00 per semester.

Technology Service Charge	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to cover technology salaries, equipment, software, and other operating costs. This fee is currently assessed@ \$17.50 per SCH.
Recreational Sports Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to cover the cost of operation for the recreational sports facility. This fee is currently assessed@ \$81.50 per semester
Distance Learning Fee	This fee is charged to all students enrolled in Web courses. This fee is currently assessed@ \$48.00 per SCH.
Library Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to help fund the costs of acquisitions for the Wildenthal Library. This fee is currently assessed@ \$8.00 per SCH.
Athletic Fee	This fee is charged to all students unless specifically exempted. This fee is used to help cover the cost of Intercollegiate Athletics. This fee is currently assessed at \$10.52 per semester credit hour.
