Cohorts

Students will progress through the program with a group of students working collaboratively in groups and actively practicing leadership skills. A new Cohort will begin each Fall.

One Year Practicum

Students will work on projects in the classroom such as creating a Professional Development Plan, creating a Collaborative Team, and creating a Targeted Improvement Plan. These projects are paired with a Practicum Course to allow certification students to implement and monitor these projects on their school campuses. The school district's partnership with SRSU will ensure that specialists employed in your district may serve as the instructors and field supervisors during this implementation and monitoring stage.

Want to serve as a Campus Leader?

This is a great degree for students who are ready to assume a leadership role on their campus as a Curriculum Specialist or Department Chair but are not wishing to move into a Principal position at this time.

Students with a SRSU Master's in Education with specialization in Educational Leadership can transfer most hours into the Certification Program when they are ready to return for Certification (subject to time deadlines).

Certification—Only is primarily for students who already have a Master's but want a Certification Program that will prepare them for the TExES 268 and PASL. This Certification—Only Plan accomplishes that goal.
