

Embedding Video into Blackboard

This example uses the Blog tool, but the process is the same for any tool in Blackboard where you have this text entry box.

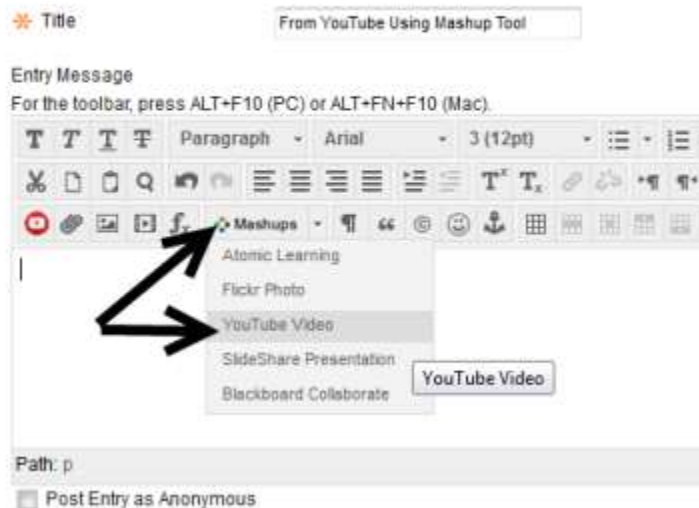


After you have uploaded your video to YouTube, click the "Create Blog Entry" button.

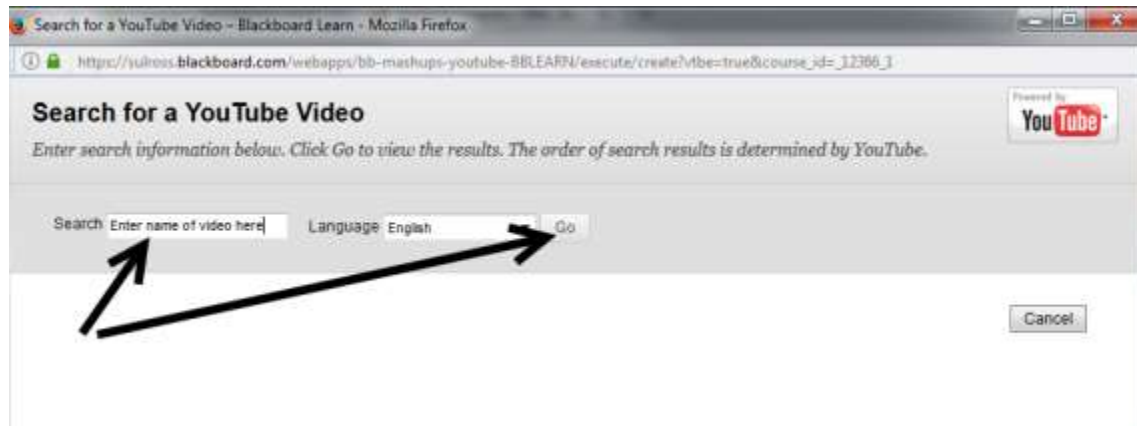


Add a title for your blog entry. In the text entry area click on the "Mashups" button and select "YouTube Video."

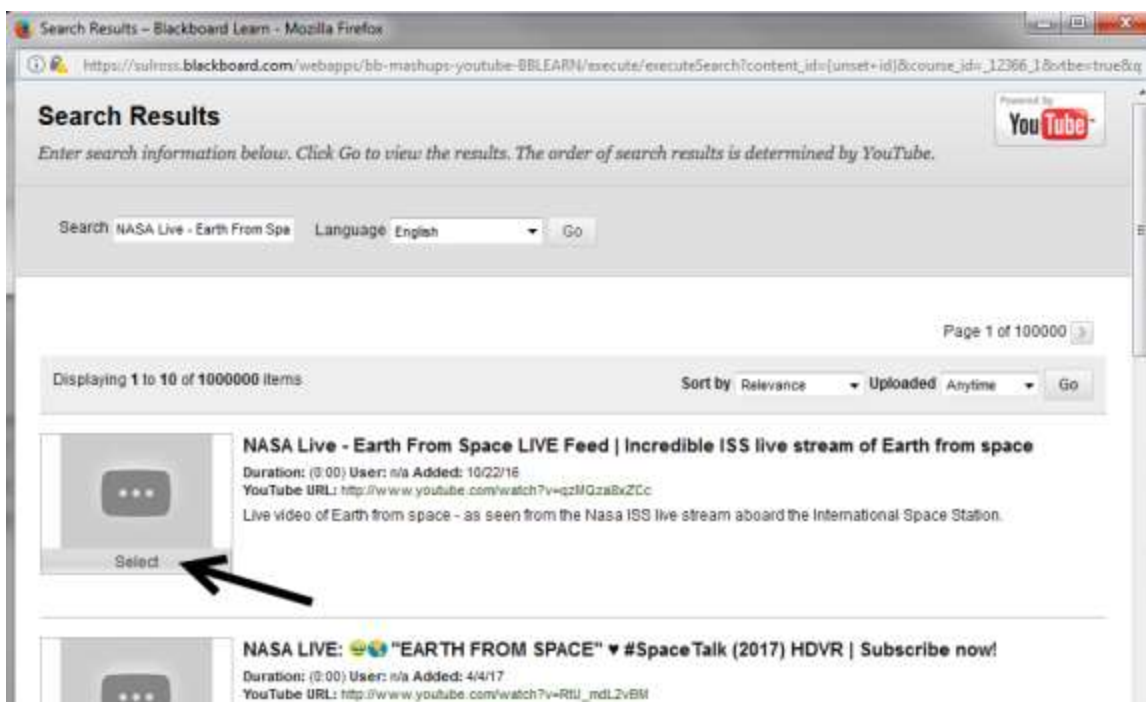
1. Blog Entry Information



A window will open. Enter the title of your video in the search field, then click the “Go” button.



Click “Select” on the video you want to embed.




From the drop down menu select “Embed Video” Then click “Submit.”

2. Mashup Options

Show YouTube URL creates a link to the YouTube web site enabling students to browse videos. Show YouTube information displays length of video, name of creator and the date video was added.

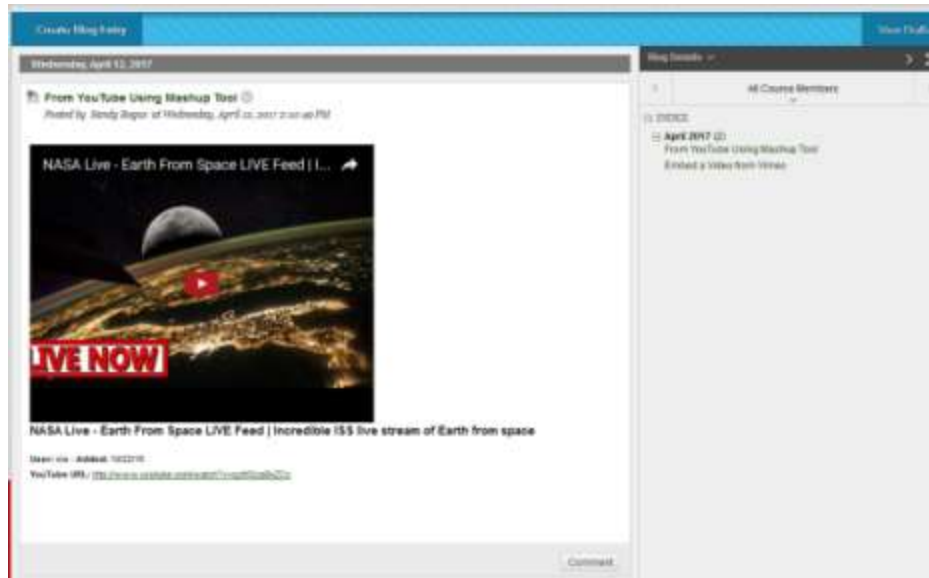

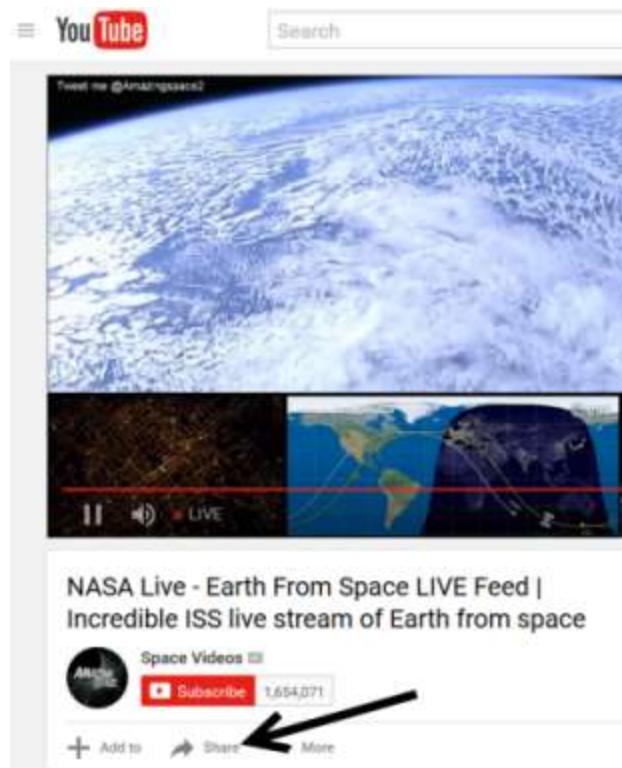

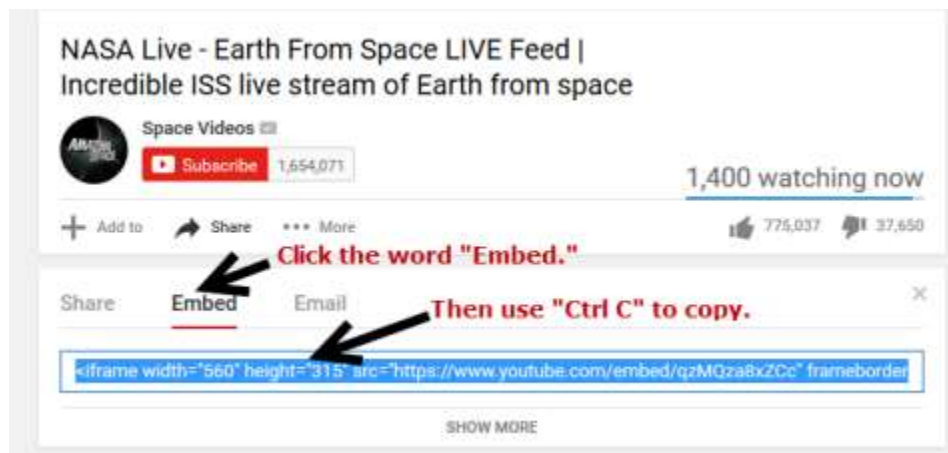
Another way to embed is to find your video on YouTube or Vimeo and look for the "Share" icon or link. It looks like this on YouTube:

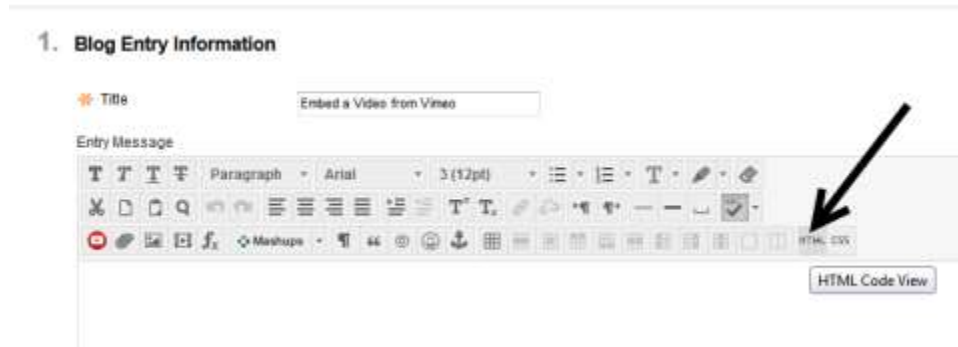

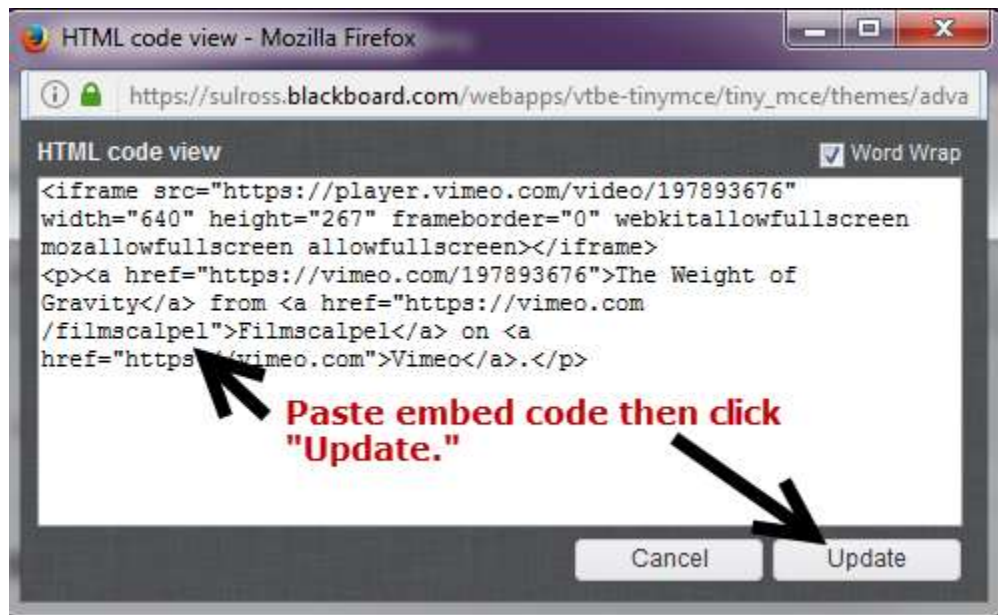

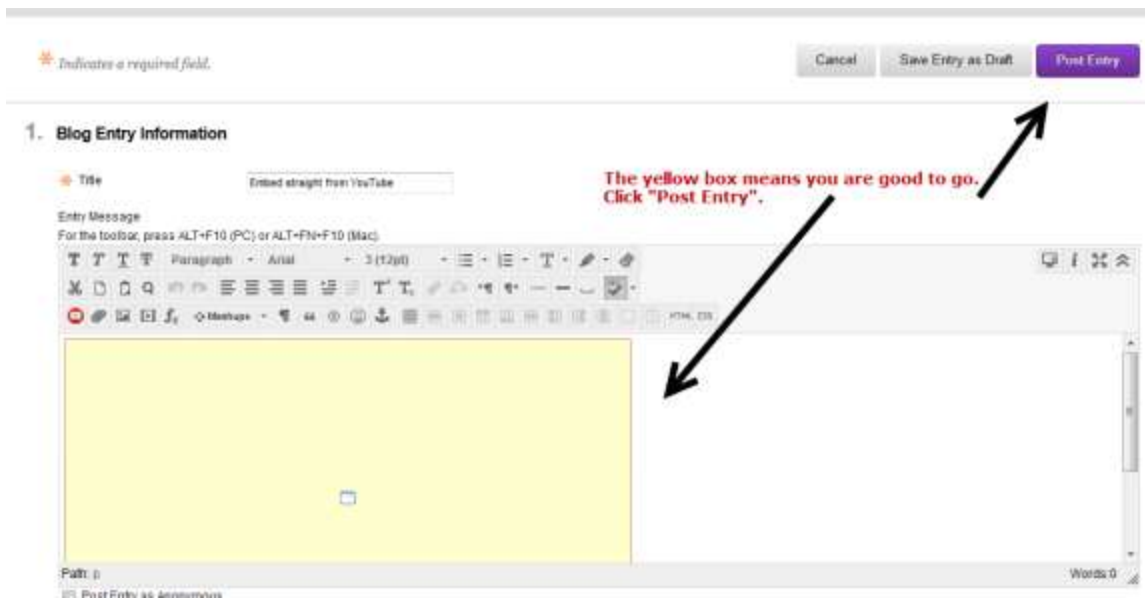
Now go back to your blog entry in Blackboard and click the “HTML” button on the edit menu. It is on the third row, second from last button.



A new window will open. Paste the embed code (“Ctrl V” or right click and select “paste” from the menu) in this window and click the “Update” button.
