- 5. Students who have taken SWTJC course ENGL 2322 may not take this course for credit and must choose another SRSU-RGC ENGL 3xxx or 4xxx course.
- 6. Students who have taken SWTJC course ENGL 2323 may not take this course for credit and must choose another SRSU-RGC ENGL 3xxx or 4xxx course.
- 7. A minor of 18 sch is required; at least 9 sch must be in upper level/advanced courses offered through SRSU-RGC. Minors are available in Biology, Business Administration, Criminal Justice, History, Mathematics, Psychology, or Spanish.
- 8. To be selected from SRSU-RGC courses ENGL 3304, 3311, 3313, 3314, 3315, 3316, 4302, 4303, 4304.
- 9. Students who have taken SWTJC course ENGL 2327 may not take this course for credit and must choose another SRSU-RGC ENGL 3xxx or 4xxx course.
- 10. Students who have taken SWTJC course ENGL 2328 may not take this course for credit and must choose another SRSU-RGC ENGL 3xxx or 4xxx course.
- 11. To be selected from SRSU-RGC courses HST 3302, 3308, 3313; SPN 3316, 3320.
