Admission to University Activities

APM 2.06 (Reviewed 4/2012)

- I. Sul Ross State University students, members of their families, and University faculty and staff, as well as members of their families, may be admitted to University activities through the use of their Student ID, Staff ID or the available activity card from the Cashier's Office.

University students who are currently registered pay a Student Service Fee based on the number of semester credit hours for which they are registered. The student I.D. card which is issued upon registration allows either free or reduced fee admission to University activities. Sul Ross students will be allowed to purchase a activity card so their spouse and children may attend University functions for a fee set by the University.

- II. A Sul Ross faculty or staff member may obtain an activity card for use by their spouse and children.
- III. These activity cards will provide the holder with either free or reduced fee admission to athletic contests, University-sponsored concerts, theatre productions, Sully Productions activities, and a variety of other University functions and activities. The Sully Productions does have the authority, on special occasions, to charge admission for special functions. In this case, the activity cards would not allow the holder free admission to the activity, but would provide a reduced admission rate from that charged the general public. In addition, those activities which are sponsored by University student organizations with a fund-raising goal may also subject the card holder to pay an additional admission fee.
