Fire Alarm Systems Upgrade is a life safety project which includes the Wildenthal Library, Ferguson Hall, Graves–Pierce, the Gallego Center and Lawrence Hall. The upgrades will replace existing equipment with state of the art fire alarm components including annunciator control systems, addressable manual pull stations, smoke detectors, duct detectors, horn/strobe devices and related equipment.

The project is on schedule with work being completed in the Graves-Pierce Complex which is scheduled for completion on February 19, 2016. The contractor will then move in the Pete P Gallego Center with the project to be complete by April 1, 2016.
