 - 8. Serve as an Academic Enhancement staff member responsible for all facets of the sport specific academic program, including the monitoring of individual student-athletes academic progress as expressed by the faculty.
 - 9. Demonstrate an active interest in the academic progress of student-athletes.
 - 10. Work closely with all appropriate departmental personnel to assure academic success of student-athletes.
 - 11. Work with student-athletes to monitor adherence to rules and regulations regarding conduct, appearance and behavior.
 - 12. Provide individual counseling to student-athletes when appropriate and direct the student-athlete to professional staff when needed.
 - 13. Work closely with the athletic training staff to insure the safety of all student-athletes.
 - 14. Perform other duties as assigned.
 - 15. Represents the sports program to various institutional programs and externally to the media, funding agencies, students, parents, faculty and the general public.
