- Coordinate practice and game coverage, schedules, rehabs, assigns responsibilities, and supervise student athletic training staff;
- Assist with budget responsibilities of inventory, purchasing and maintenance of supplies and materials;
- Ensure compliance of Federal Rules and Regulations (HIPAA) regarding confidentiality and electronic communication;
