## **Summary**

Function: To supervise and provide skilled leadership to the carpenters, painters and maintenance staff within the Building Maintenance Department.

Scope: Maintenance, renovation and construction as assigned to all University structures, interior and exterior, University wide.

#### **Duties**

Essential: Progressively plan, schedule and supervise the safe and efficient implementation of the following: Typical carpentry and painting functions that meet or exceed industry standards, daily maintenance functions, prepare estimates, oversee the layout, construction and punch-out of assigned projects, requisition of materials, oversee the operating and quality control of the carpenter and paint shops, including locks, framing, structural repairs, surface repairs and matching colors, oversee inventory transactions from General Stores as related, perform preventive and corrective maintenance on all shop tools and equipment, organize and maintain an adequate record keeping program, maintain good relations with all members and visitors of the campus community. Other duties as assigned. Must practice and train SAFETY FIRST. Responsible for personal safety and the safety of others; must exercise due caution and practice safe work habits at all times.
