Practice proper safety procedures and use personal protective devices. Other duties as assigned. Responsible for personal safety and the safety of others; must exercise due caution and practice safe work habits at all times.

Supervision

Received: From Utilities Foreman and guidance from heating and refrigeration mechanics.

Education

Required: High school graduate or equivalent.

Preferred: Journeyman level training or graduate from vocational school.

Experience

Required: Knowledge of material, methods, and operation of mechanical and/or electrical systems.

Preferred: Pipe fitter, air conditioning mechanic.

Equipment/Skills

Required: Knowledge and ability to use basic tools of the mechanical and/or electrical trade.

Preferred: Diagnostic tools and electrical trouble shooting devices. Back hoe and loader operator.

Working Conditions

Usual: University wide maintenance; position is Security Sensitive.

Special: After hours "on call" availability required.

Other

Current driver's license and driving record acceptable to the University must be maintained as a condition of employment.
