

WHAT TO BRING

EVERYONE

- Personal items, toiletries, beddings/linens
- Shower curtains and curtain rings, bins for additional storage
- Computer/Laptop (WiFi provided)
- Desk lamp, clock, area rugs, fans
- TV and streaming devices (cable/satellite TV services not available)
- Small trash can and trash bags
- Cleaning appliances (broom, mop, and vacuum cleaner)
- Air fresheners such as plug-ins, reed diffusers, sprays, and beads
- Wall decorations with painter's tape and/or command strips
- Power strip that includes surge protection to reduce electrical outages (extension cords not allowed)
- ***With prior approval**, you can have service animals, assistance animals, or fish in max 10-gallon tank

Tips: Coordinate with your roommate about which items you will share. You can connect with your roommate via StarRez Housing Portal once you have been assigned.

*Animal approval (except fish) is a two-step process. Start the conversation by contacting the Office of Counseling and Accessibility Services at (432) 837-8203. Animals cannot be on-campus until they have been approved. Get this done in advance!

RESIDENCE HALL SPECIFICS (LV 1, LV 2, AND FLETCHER)

- Linens for extra-long twin bed (80 x 38.5 inches)
- **Keurig (coffee pots not allowed)
- **Blender
- **Crockpot that is 3-Quart or smaller

APARTMENT SPECIFICS (LV 3 - 7)

- Efficiency and Lobo Pack Double Apartments: Linens for extra-long twin bed (80 x 38.5 inches)
- Family Housing & Employee Housing Apartments: Linens for up to two extra-long twin beds (80 x 38.5 inches) and one queen bed
- **Cooking appliances
- **Microwave

**Appliances should display the "Underwriters Laboratory" (UL) approval

***Fletcher hall is equipped with central A/C. All fans and space heaters should display the UL approval

WHAT NOT TO BRING

EVERYONE

- Wireless routers
- *Extra furniture (units are fully furnished)
- Air conditioners or space heaters
- Pets/unapproved animals
- Vapes, cigarettes, any smoking devices (Sul Ross is a smoke-free campus)
- Halogen lamps and any plug-in LED/Christmas lights
- Candles, incense, fireworks, lighters or any other flammable materials
- Heated elements that could be left unattended for long period of time (such as wickless candles on a heated melter, scented light bulb rings) and which require heat to release scent
- **Weapons or anything resembling a weapon (including firearms in which their owners are not License to Carry (LTC) Holders, toy or airsoft gun, large knives and blades longer than 5.5 inches, any device powered by CO2 cartridges any device that expels any type of projectile, and explosives and ammunition of any type)

*All units are fully furnished. Students may not remove or exchange furniture from common areas or between units. There is not storage available on-campus for residents to store any university or personal furniture.

**For valid LTC holders, you may carry a concealed handgun in all residential facilities. License holders residing in campus housing are responsible for the safe storage of their handgun and ammunition whenever they are not on or about their person. Handgun storage must be approved by the Director of Residential Living.

RESIDENCE HALL SPECIFICS (LV 1, LV 2, AND FLETCHER)

- Appliances such as
 - Hot plates, skillets, air fryers, toaster ovens, grills
 - Additional microwaves, additional refrigerators of any size, hot air poppers, coffee pots (only Keurig is allowed), waffle/panini makers
- Alcohol (regardless of age) and illegal drugs

APARTMENT SPECIFICS (LV 3 - 7)

- ***Barbecue grills
- ***Trampolines, swing sets, etc.
- Satellite dishes
- Horse trailers, travel trailers, or boats
- ***Lawn mowers and other yard equipment
- Washer and Dryer
- Alcohol (if you are under the legal drinking age) and illegal drugs

***Items are not allowed to be stored in the breezeways/hallways
