

Option 1: Payment in full for tuition, fees, room and board

If you choose to pay your balance in full, you will need to pay the **total** tuition and fees for **ALL** registered courses by the last day of Late Registration.

Option 2: Enroll in the Installment Payment Plan

Students owing past due balances are not eligible for this plan.

Note: Installment plans will NOT be posted to your account until \$50 down payment is made.

Installment Plan amounts are split up into equal installments. See below for dates.

A down payment of \$50 is due at the time of enrollment into the payment plan. Equal installments of the remaining balance will be due on the designated due dates as shown above.

Additional Plan Information:

- A \$25 **non-refundable** set-up fee is assessed for enrollment into the installment payment plan.
- A \$15 late fee for *each* missed payment date will be assessed; however, your classes will not be canceled.
- Scheduled payments via a credit card or bank account are required.
- **All previous semester balances must be paid prior to enrollment.**
- The Payment Plan will recalculate as charges increase or decrease due to schedule changes.
- If you are a financial aid recipient, your financial aid cannot be used to assist with enrollment into the payment plan until it is disbursed 10 days prior to the first day of classes.

In order to enroll in the payment plan, go to your MySRSU account. After logging in, click on the Student Dashboard then Student Services and then Student Account Suite (Bill + Payment). After reading the Welcome Page, scroll to the bottom and click on Continue to Student Account Suite. Account Suite will open in a new browser window. From here, you can enroll in the payment plan by making the down payment by credit card, debit card, or by setting up a deduction directly from your bank account (ACH). If you are unable to make the first payment at that time, you may be eligible to sign up for a short-term loan.
