ANNOUNCEMENT

Sul Ross State University (SRSU) will host the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) accreditation visitors from November 1-3, 2021 when CCNE conducts its virtual accreditation visit for our BSN program including both the RN to BSN track and the pre-licensure BSN track. CCNE is the nationally recognized accrediting agency for baccalaureate and graduate degree programs in nursing education. The last CCNE accreditation for the SRSU BSN Program occurred in 2016.

As part of the evaluation process, CCNE provides the opportunity for third-party communities of interest and program constituents to submit written comments regarding the SRSU program's qualifications for accreditation. CCNE shares third-party comments with members of the evaluation team before the visit, but at no time during the review process are these comments shared with the program. During its review of Sul Ross State University Nursing Program, the evaluation team only considers third-party comments that relate to the CCNE accreditation standards. (http://www.ccneaccreditation.org). All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English and consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English. Only author-identified (signed) comments will be accepted by CCNE for inclusion in the accreditation review process.

Interested parties may submit written comments to CCNE concerning SRSU BSN Nursing Program qualifications for accreditation until 21 days before the virtual accreditation visit. All comments must be received by CCNE no later than October 11, 2021 and should be submitted to thirdpartycomments@ccneaccreditation.org.
