ANSWER: Blackboard will continue to support the original course view through 2024, but our TSUS Partnership would like for all partner schools to be completely in Ultra by 2024.

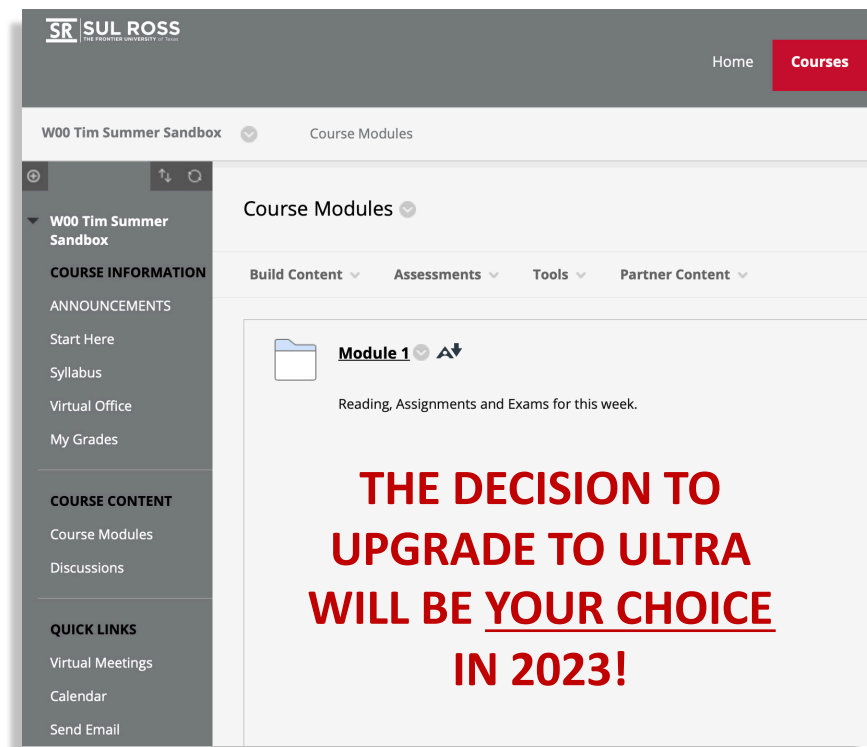
MEANING: SRSU instructors should be actively moving to Ultra for summer/fall 2023.

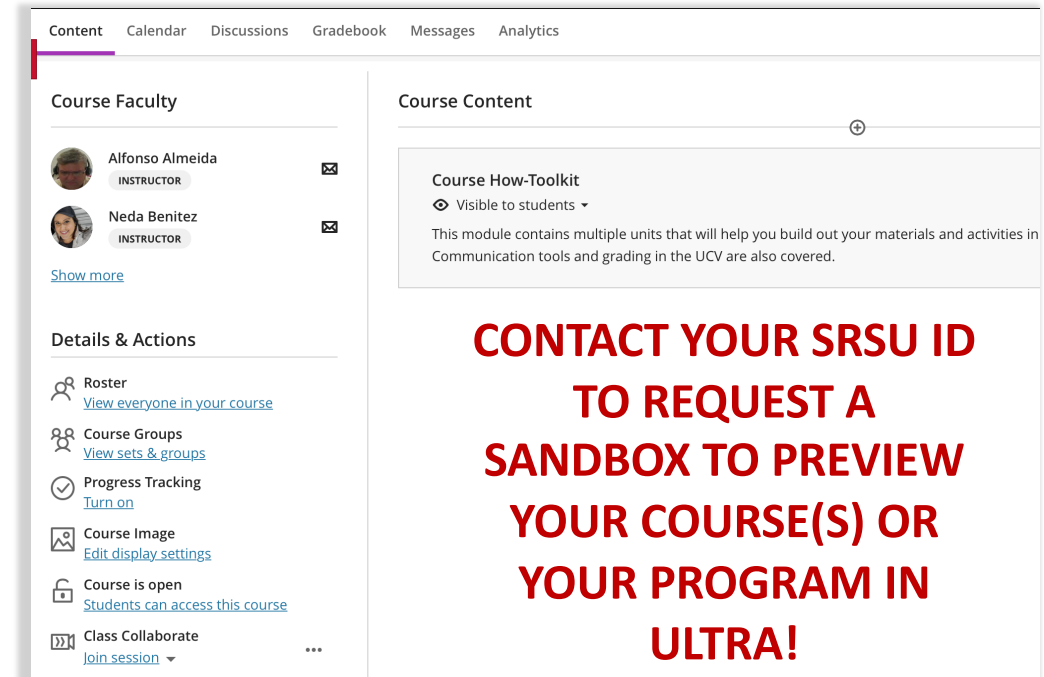




Upcoming SHSU On-Site Ultra Boot Camps Sul Ross Campuses
