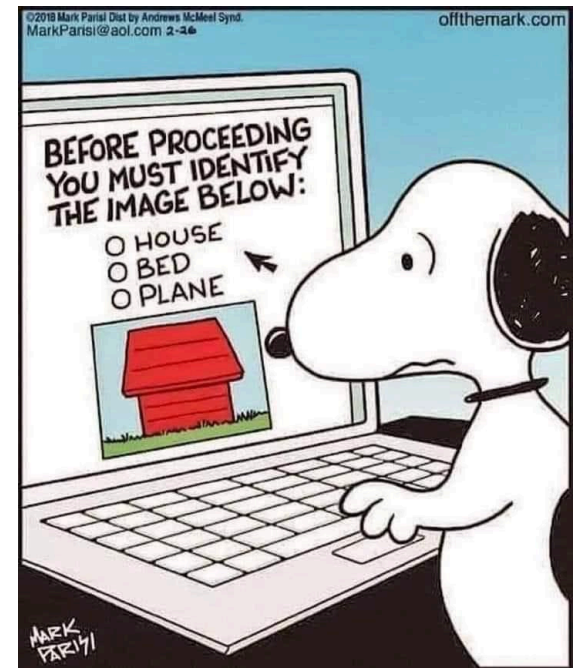
GRANTS
