

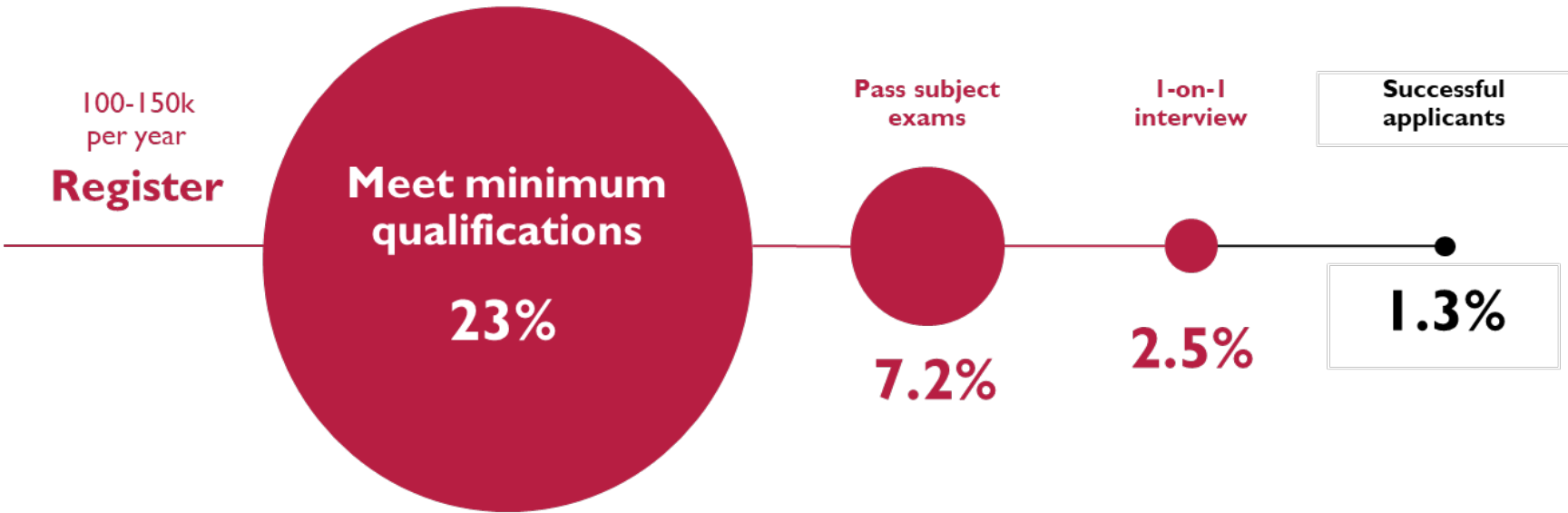

1) Thesis Statement: Clear and focused thesis

Thesis statement target feedback:

Welcome to Tutor.com! It was a pleasure to read the beginnings of your essay on whether or not outside influences should contact uncontacted tribes. You had not completed the entirety of your essay, but rather submitted an introduction and one body paragraph, which I was able to review for you. When you are all done, submit again for a more complete and comprehensive look. Let's take a look at your thesis statement together now, and talk about how you can improve it moving forward!

Here is your thesis statement currently: "These tribes could be in danger or in need of aid. Americans should explore uncontacted tribes to help them because it is our responsibility as humanity and it is best to contact them in a civil manner."

Now that we've reviewed that, let's take a moment to talk about the elements and structure of a strong thesis statement, and then apply it to yours above.

A thesis statement has several parts. First, it establishes the main argument of the essay and the position of the author. For example: Social media has a negative effect on teenagers' self-esteem...

Then, you want to include your main supporting reasons. For example: Social media has a negative effect on teenagers' self-esteem as evidence by increased eating disorders, higher suicide rates, and higher rates of depression.

Notice how I include both my argument and my supporting details for a strong thesis that also provides a road-map for the rest of the essay!

In your introduction, you mentioned one supporting reason: that the tribes may be in need of aid. However, this was not included as part of the thesis statement, which would be helpful. Try placing this in your thesis statement for a more straightforward and all-encompassing thesis. Next, try including two other supporting reasons for a well-rounded essay. 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
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
