Admission Requirements for RN to BSN Track

Sul Ross State University offers an RN to BSN Completion track across the entire state of Texas. Program graduates possess the potential for evidence-informed clinical judgment, ethical comportment, assessment skills, direct patient care, nursing leadership, and management potential in a community setting as they assume leadership roles on the health-care team. The SRSU RN to BSN program offers 100% online, asynchronous courses delivered in 8-week formats to provide flexibility for working nurses.

Students interested in applying for admission to the RN to BSN program must:

- 1. Be admitted to Sul Ross State University (SRSU).
- 2. Have a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 on a 4-point scale.
- 3. Have an unencumbered RN license (Texas or compact), or be enrolled in an ADN program for dual enrollment conditional acceptance.
- 4. Submit all official transcripts from colleges and universities previously attended to the Office of Admissions at SRSU.

Application Requirements

Application Cycles

Admission is on a rolling basis and is divided into the following semester starts:

Fall, Spring, Summer

Enrollment in Nursing Courses

Once a student is accepted in to the RN to BSN Program, the Program advisor will send an email with instructions on registering for courses.

Program Length

The SRSU RN to BSN program can be completed in 2-3 semesters or 30 semester credit hours upon completion of all core and requisite courses. If dual enrolled, must pass NCLEX prior to last semester.
