SRSU is following the anticipated <u>State Holiday Schedule</u> for Fiscal Year 2026 with the option, under the Texas Government Code § 662.011 to group many holidays near the winter break. Per the state controller, the number of available weekday holidays for FY26 is fourteen with six Administrative Days. The following alternative days may be observed in lieu of a university holiday:

Rosh Hashanah September 23-24 Yom Kippur October 2 Cesar Chavez Day March 31 Good Friday April 3

Due to university closure during scheduled holidays, employees observing alternative days shall be charged available vacation, compensatory time, or unpaid leave to account for the alternative day. The total number of holidays in a year to which an employee is entitled is not changed by use of alternative holidays.
