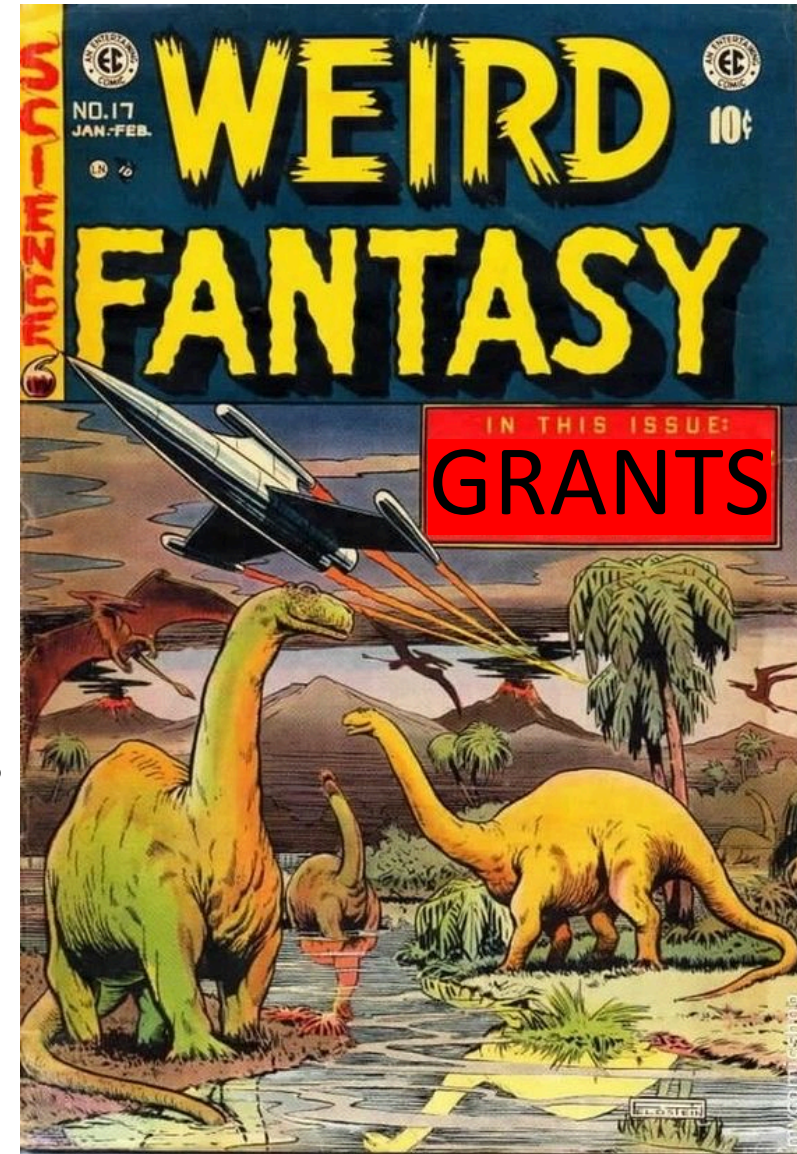

- Concept Leadership Appropriate for Our Institution (as it truly is) and Our Students (as they truly are)

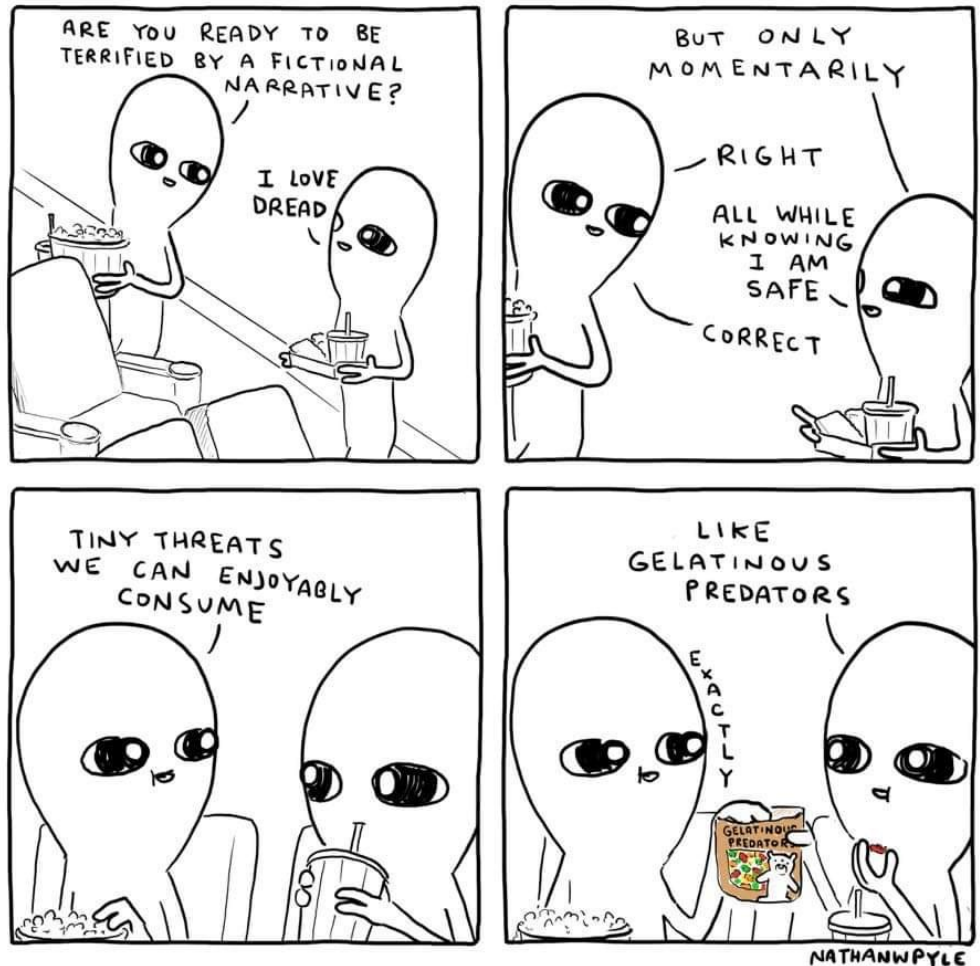
