



- Concept Leadership Appropriate for Our Institution (as it truly is) and Our Students (as they truly are)

























WAHT ish Happpendings?

- Wednesday 09/10/2025: Title V Discontinuance announcements received.
- Friday responses begin trickling in from actual DOE personnel.
- Monday 09/15/2025: Key Administration meet to discuss likely interpretations of Announcements and badly written letters.
- Wednesday 09/17/2025: Title 3 STEM LTS is defunded.
- Wednesday: Kendall is promoted to Acting Assistant Secretary of the Office of Postsecondary Education.
- Thursday: Kendall is demoted from the position of Assistant Secretary. Jolve Mc'Chalkface is his apparent replacement.
- Thursday 09/18/2025: DOE employees begin weighing in on Title III STEM Part F interpretations.
