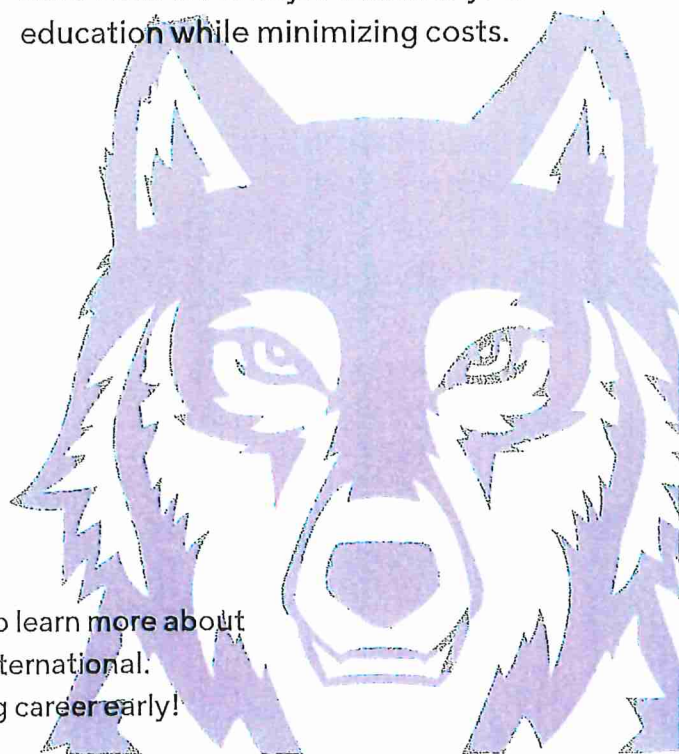

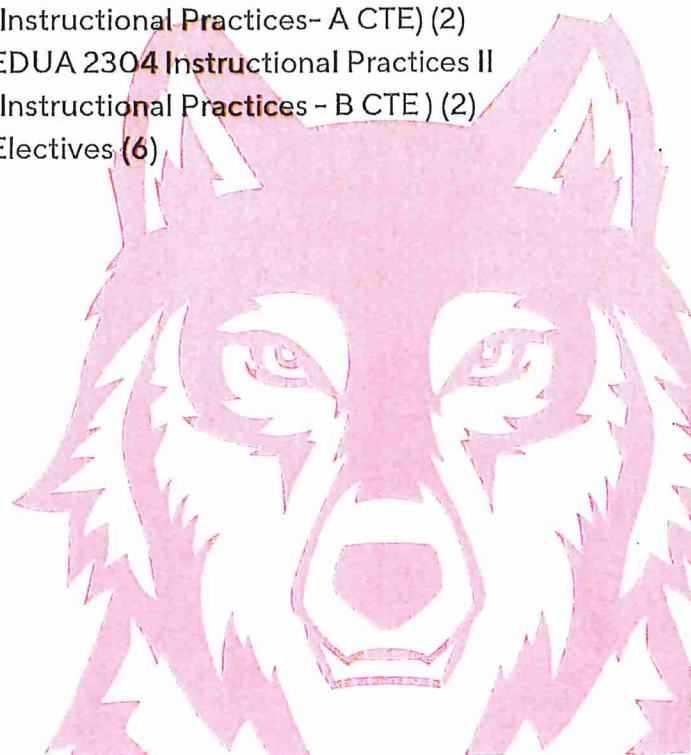

1. A HEALTH SCIENCES DUAL CREDIT PATHWAY (GRADES 9-12)
2. A FULLY INTEGRATED NURSING ACADEMY (TEXAS CORE + NURSING PREREQUISITES)

Both pathways offer direct entry into Sul Ross health-related degree programs after high school graduation.

Health Sciences Dual Credit Pathway (Grades 9-12)

Freshman Year (Level 1): Introduction to Health Sciences

- Two-semester course (3 credits total)
- Fall: 2 credits | Spring: 1 credit
- Face-to-face delivery by ISD instructors
- Must pass both semesters for credit

Sophomore Year (Level 2): Medical Terminology

- 3 credits
- Face-to-face by ISD instructors or online

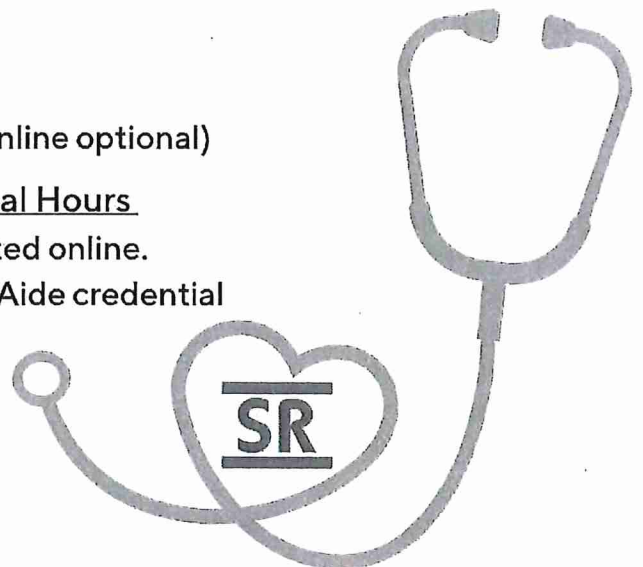
Junior Year (Level 3): Anatomy & Physiology I and II

- 8 credits total
- Face-to-face by Sul Ross or STEM science faculty (online optional)

Senior Year (Level 4): Pathophysiology + CNA Clinical Hours

- 3 credits plus 1 credit lab (optional) - Can be completed online.
- Completion of clinical hours toward Certified Nurse Aide credential

Total Potential College Credit: 17 Hours

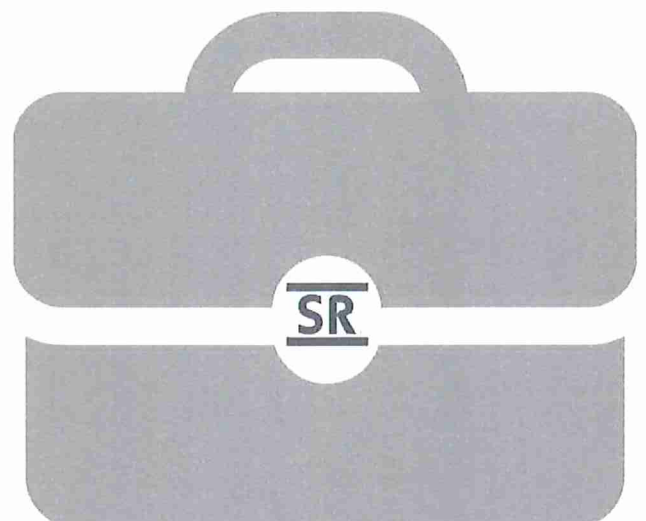

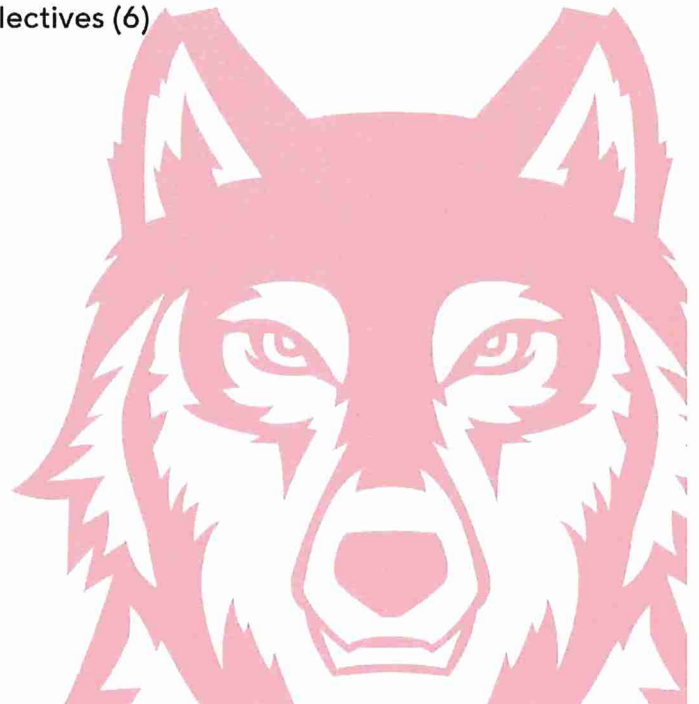
